Macedonia has committed to feed and house 14 homeless men on the 2nd and 4th Monday nights for the next few months.

Here is what occurs.

Travel Arrangements: Homeless men are screened for readiness to come, and those who pass the tests are picked up by our men of the church. They are returned to designated place in Lexington the following morning.

Meals: Volunteers have an evening dinner ready for them upon their arrival. A sack lunch is prepared for the next day. An early hot breakfast is prepared for them the next morning.

Bedding: Air mattresses are set up in two rooms in the upstairs of the original church building. In preparation for this - sheets, blankets and pillow cases are washed after each use.

Fellowship: Volunteer church members eat dinner with the men. Thereafter, a movie is shown to them in the lower level of the church.

Amenities: The men may make use of the showers. Towels, soap, deodorant, and other personal items are provided. Bibles and devotionals are available to them for the taking.

Security: At least two church men stay all night.

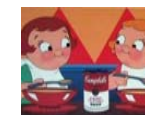
